
Explore the world of 3D using simple materials around your home. Create a character expressing your different moods or the faces of your family, friends or neighbors.

- Color pencils, markers or crayons


How to Do It!

- 2. Start with the template that include arms. Draw and color fun outfits on each of the rectangles. Color and decorate the arms.


