## **Animal Observation**

Scientists who study animal behavior are called ethologists. They use a data sheet called an ethogram to record the animal behavior they observe.

Choose <u>one</u> ape at the Zoo to observe for 5 minutes. Every thirty seconds, record that animal's (and only that animal's) behavior. If the animal goes to a place where you cannot see it, just record it as "out of view." Don't switch to a different individual animal during your observation period.
