

### Going to the ABQ BioPark Zoo for Camp BioPark




### Today I am going to the Albuquerque BioPark Zoo for summer camp!




Before I go inside, my parents will sign me in with my teacher. I may have to wait for the other kids to show up too. I will then walk into the zoo with my camp.




# My teacher will go over what we are going to do for the day.

Some exhibits may be closed and animals may be sleeping. I can come back another time if they are.






Some areas of the zoo may be loud or smell differently. I can ask for a break if I need one.




#### I may get a little messy during arts and crafts.
