**Proposed changes to the Regulations Governing Soliciting in the H-1 Historic Old Town Zone, pursuant to §13-3-2-18:**

The Board made it about half way thru the proposed changes to the Regulation developing a consensus on how the proposed changes might be modified in order to receive an endorsement by the Board.

**Buying from wholesalers and other various items on the Portal Market:**

The Portal Market Manager, after having consulted with the City's Legal department, reported back to the committee:

Purchasing items outdoors from a wholesaler or person is not allowed by the Historic Old Town Solicitation Ordinance.

The City is asking that such activity be taken "off the Plaza", ideally somewhere indoors or beyond the Historic Old Town Zone.

This applies to the physical handling and selection of merchandise and is not meant to interfere in any way with conversations between vendors and wholesalers, nor is it meant to interfere with the delivery of any items or product to Portal Market Vendors while on the Portal.
