ITEM 2: UPDATES AND DISCUSSION

- A) Update on Meeting Between City Legal & Board Chair, Janie McGuigan regarding Comcast Customer Complaints and reporting (disposition).
 - 1. The conference call meeting did not happen.
 - Jon Lehman, Comcast, Mountain West Region, Senior Director Government & Regulatory Affairs and Erin Muffoletto, Comcast, Mountain West Region, External Affairs Manager agreed to a virtual meeting on June 25th and NEITHER made the call.
 - 3. Joseph Lynch will schedule a meeting with City Legal and Janie McGuigan, Board Chair to discuss next steps.

- 4. Brent Chapman, City Attorney, City Legal Department mentioned that as per the Comcast Franchise agreement: failure to maintain records (e.g. customer complaints) is a breach of the franchise agreement.
- 5. The question going forward is What remedies does the City and board have? Is there a possibility of liquidated damages?
- B) Update on Board collaboration with Broadband Office, Department of Innovation & Technology
 - Anthony Rodriguez, Business Technology Specialist, Department of Arts & Culture is
 discussing with Catherine Nicolaou, Broadband Manager to come up with a video script to
 educate the public about Fiber Optics (Broadband). The video should be general, more
 informative and not a call to action. It will be a short video that would serve as a Public
 Service Announcement to inform the citizens of Albuquerque about the features of
 Broadband.
 - 2. Willard Hunter thinks that Albuquerque is way behind many other Cities. He would like to get a better understanding of the contracted fiber optic service providers' plans for their buildout in Albuquerque. Per this discussion, Board members also agreed to develop a list of Fiber Optic questions for discussion by John Osmon and all members at next Board meeting.
