ORDER

This matter came before the Intragovernmental Conference Committee on the Petition of the Mayor, submitted April 1, 2025 (and the Notice of Errata submitted May 1, 2025), and the Response of the City Council, submitted April 16, 2025. The Committee heard argument from the parties on June 3, 2025 and continued its deliberations on June 16, 2025, after which it announced the ruling memorialized herein.

Pursuant to Article XIX of the City Charter and Revised Ordinances of Albuquerque, Sections 2-16-1 through 2-16-5, the Committee, by a 2-1 vote, rules that the Council does not have the power under the City Charter to specify staffing requirements in Council Bill No. R-25-122 (Enactment No. R-2025-011) with the degree of specificity that it includes for the reasons set forth in the Committee's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, issued July 7, 2025.

Committee Member Vanzi would rule that the Council does have the power to enact Council Bill No. R-25-122 (Enactment No. R-2025-011) to "[e]stablish[] minimum staffing requirements for Albuquerque Fire Rescue, Rescue Apparatus."

It is therefore ordered by majority vote that Council Bill No. R-25-122 (Enactment No. R-2025-011) is void and of no effect.

It is so ordered.
