## AMENDED ORDER REGARDING CONDUCT OF EVIDENTIARY HEARING

THIS MATTER was referred to the City of Albuquerque Board of Ethics and Campaign Practices by the City Clerk. The matter presently is set for an evidentiary hearing on September 10, 2021.

With regard to the evidentiary hearing, the Board orders as follows:

1. The Evidentiary Hearing shall be held for a total of no more than <u>120</u> minutes from 9:00 AM until <u>11:00</u> AM on September 10, 2021. The time shall be divided equally between Complainant and Respondent. During their allotted time, each party will be afforded an opportunity to make opening and closing statements and to present evidence in support of their respective positions in the form of witness testimony, documents and other submissions.

2. No later than 5:00 PM on Monday, September 6, 2021, counsel for each party shall submit a brief containing legal authorities related to the legal issues to be considered by the Board at the evidentiary hearing. The briefs shall limited to no more than 7 double spaced pages. No response briefs by either party are permitted. Briefs must be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk via email addressed to mdiemer@cabq.gov.

3. The parties also are required to comply with all other submission deadlines set out in the Rules and Regulations of the Board of Ethics and Campaign Practices.
