Mr. Perlman moved to find facially valid. Mr Montoya seconded. Voted and passed 2-0. Board granted City 10 days to reply to PPC.

• LB 24-08 FACIAL VALIDITY SCREENING FOR NEW PROHIBITED PRACTICE COMPLAINT FILED BY STAFF REPRESENTATIVE JOEL VILLARREAL ON BEHALF OF AFSCME LOCAL 2962, COUNCIL 18, AGAINST THE CITY OF ALBUQUERQUE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR VIOLATING THE LMRO AND ARTICLES 0.3 AND 1.9 OF THE CBA BY UNILATERALLY INCREASING WORKLOADS WITHOUT PROVIDING NOTICE AND/OR NEGOTIATING WITH THE UNION.

Attorney Jessica Serrano appeared on behalf of the City. Joel Villarreal and Stephanie Gomez appeared on behalf of AFSCME 2962.

Attorney Serrano stated the City is requesting clarification on how the City allegedly violated Articles 0.3 and 1.9. Mr. Villarreal stated it is the LMRO the Union feels was violated. Mr. Villarreal stated the State of New Mexico had found in very similar situations where unilateral changes to workload without bargaining were upheld, that this broad of a statement was allowed. Mr. Perlman and Mr. Montoya were not in agreement on the facial validity and would like to schedule for a continued facial validity hearing on 4/22/24, when all 3 Board Members should be present.

VII. ADJOURNMENT.

Mr. Perlman moved to adjourn. Mr. Montoya seconded. Adjourned at 9:26 am.
