I believe Councilor Bassan, as a City Councilor, is violating Section 7 of Article XXII, the City Code of Ethics. Section 7 deals with the Misuse of City Employees in Campaigns. In Section 7 (A), states that no official shall participate in the following types of political activity: "Using his or her position or employment with the city to influence support of employees of the city for or against any candidate, issue or Measure Finance Committee or other similar organization in any election or pre-election activity; provided, however, that nothing herein shall deny the right of an official of the city to express his or her views on any issue."

Councilor Bassan employs Dawn Marie Emillio as her policy analyst with the Albuquerque City Council. Emillio is believed to be a resident of the City of Albuquerque based on public records that showed she was recently registered to vote at 10208 Delbert Ave NW, Albuquerque, NM, 87114. That residence is on Albuquerque's Westside, and outside City Council District 4, which is represented by Councilor Bassan. According to public records, Emillio changed her voting address on April 23, 2023 to 9000 Modesto Ave NE, Albuquerque, NM, 87122, but maintains her mailing address on the Westside at 10344 Mogollon Dr NW Albuquerque, NM 87114.

9000 Modesto Ave. NE is the residence that Councilor Bassan lists on city records as her home.

While it is unclear whether Emillio physically moved into Councilor Bassan's home, it appears Bassan intends to allow her residence to be used for Emillio's voter registration address, so that Emillio can vote for Bassan in the upcoming city election as a resident of Council District 4.

On June 6, Ms. Emilio signed Bassan's nominating petition for office and contributed \$5 to her publicly financed campaign, swearing she lives at Ms. Bassan's address.

Her voter registration cards show that she has kept her mailing address on the Westside, but only changed her voter registration.

I am concerned that Councilor Bassan is using her position as a City Councilor and direct supervisor of Emillio to encourage and consent for Emillio to change her voter registration and vote for Bassan in the upcoming election.

I am concerned that Bassan broke additional city laws regarding public financing. Part 8: Petitions (2023 Regulations of the Albuquerque City Clerk for the Election Code and the Open and Ethical Election Code) deals with fraudulent Qualifying Contributions for Public financing and petition signatures. This section says, "Candidates may be held responsible for violations of these rules by either paid or unpaid (volunteer) circulators".

"Section C. <u>Submitted any fraudulent Qualifying Contributions</u> or Qualifying Contributions that were not made by the named contributor, and the <u>Participating Candidate knew or should have known of the fraudulence</u>:

d. Misrepresented to a contributor the purpose of the Qualifying Contribution or obtaining the contributor's signature on the receipt and acknowledgement form

and the Participating Candidate knew or should have known of the misrepresentation:

f. Knowingly made a false statement or material misrepresentation in any report or other document required to be filed under the OEEC, EC or the City Clerk's Rules and Regulations; or

Although outside the purview of the Board of Ethics, for context, it seems that state election laws have also been broken (New Mexico <u>Election Code</u> ARTICLE 20 Offenses and Penalties). Whoever commits any of these violations is guilty of a fourth degree felony.

### 1-20-8. False voting.

False voting consists of:

- A. voting or offering to vote with the knowledge of not being a qualified elector;
- E. inducing, abetting or procuring or attempting to induce, abet or procure a person known to not be a qualified elector to vote; or

### 1-20-3. Registration offenses.

Registration offenses consist of performing any of the following acts willfully and with knowledge and intent to deceive any registration officer or to subvert the registration requirements of the law or rights of any qualified elector:

- A. signing or offering to sign a certificate of registration when not a qualified elector;
- B. falsifying any information on the certificate of registration;

### 1-20-8.1. Conduct of election; fraudulent and double voting.

Every person not entitled to vote who fraudulently votes, and every person who votes or offers to vote more than once at any one election.

### 1-20-9. Falsifying election documents.

Falsifying election documents consists of performing any of the following acts willfully and with knowledge and intent to deceive or mislead any voter, precinct board [election board], canvassing board or other election official:

- D. suppressing any certificate of nomination, registration record or election return required by or prepared and issued pursuant to the Election Code;
- E. preparing or submitting any false certificate of nomination, registration record or election return; or
- F. knowingly falsifying any information on a nominating petition.

### 1-20-10. False swearing.

False swearing consists of taking any oath required by the Election Code [Chapter 1 NMSA 1978] with the knowledge that the thing or matter sworn to is not a true and correct statement.

### 1-20-15. Conspiracy to violate Election Code.

Conspiracy to violate the Election Code [Chapter 1 NMSA 1978] consists of knowingly combining, uniting or agreeing with any other person to omit any duty or commit any act, the omission of which duty, or combination of such act, would by the provisions of the Election Code constitute a fourth degree felony.

### 10-16-3.1. Prohibited political activities.

A public officer or employee is prohibited from:

- A. directly or indirectly coercing or attempting to coerce another public officer or employee to pay, lend or contribute anything of value to a party, committee, organization, agency or person for a political purpose;
- B. threatening to deny a promotion or pay increase to an employee who does or does not vote for certain candidates, requiring an employee to contribute a percentage of the employee's pay to a political fund, influencing a subordinate employee to purchase a ticket to a political fundraising dinner or similar event, advising an employee to take part in political activity or similar activities; or
- C. violating the officer's or employee's duty not to use property belonging to a state agency or local government agency, or allow its use, for other than authorized purposes.

## City Councilor Brook Bassan's Voter Fraud Cover Up Bassan's "no comment" and Emillio's strained and carefully-worded response stinks of a cover-up

ALBUQUERQUE, Monday, October 30, 2023—This morning, Dave Esdale, a District 4 resident will be filing an Ethics Complaint against Brook Bassan with the City of Albuquerque Board of Ethics alleging that Bassan has engaged in voter fraud to support her re-election campaign.

In the blog by <u>Joe Monahan</u> today, Monahan reported Bassan had "no comment" and instead had her assistant respond to the allegations, saying she temporarily moved in with Bassan "for personal reasons."

Follow up questions to Bassan may be:

- How long did Emillio live with Bassan?
- If the stay was permanent enough to go through the trouble of changing her voter registration (coinciding with her boss' reelection campaign and public financing process), why did Emillio keep her mailing address at her partner's house on the Westside?
- Emilio stated that she has since moved out of Bassan's house. Why didn't she change her registration when she moved out?
- Bassan has prided herself on being forthright with the voters. What role did Bassan play in this temporary change of registration?
- Did Bassan suggest that a public employee she supervises change her voter registration to benefit her campaign?
- Is this another "simple mistake" like lying about her education credentials?
- Emillio is at risk of facing serious state charges for voter fraud. Was she instructed to do so by her employer?

Engaging in voter fraud is reckless and fundamentally hurts the public trust in elections and democracy. With the election just eight days away, Bassan owes it to voters to respond truthfully and immediately to these allegations of voter fraud and a cover up.
