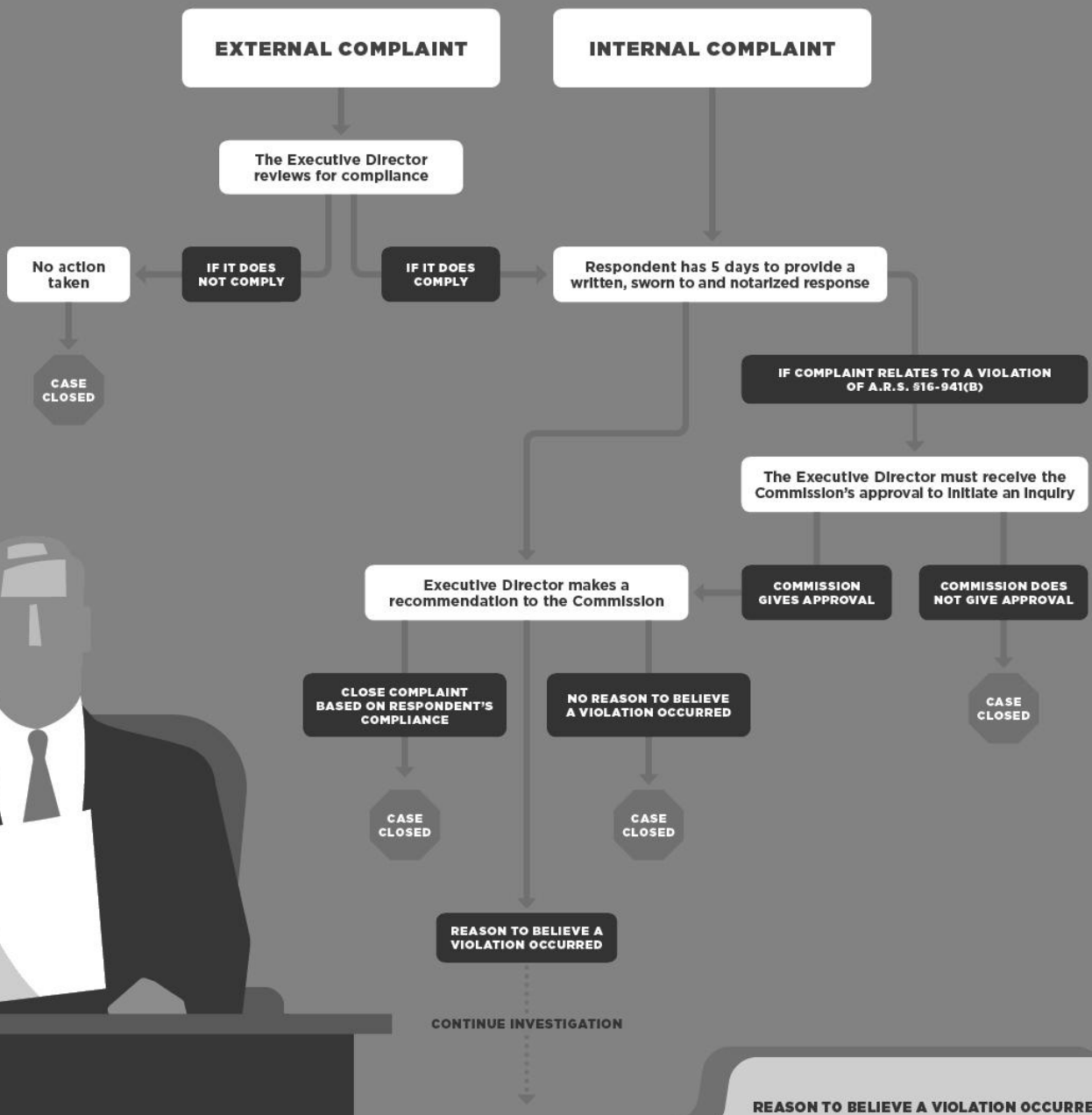


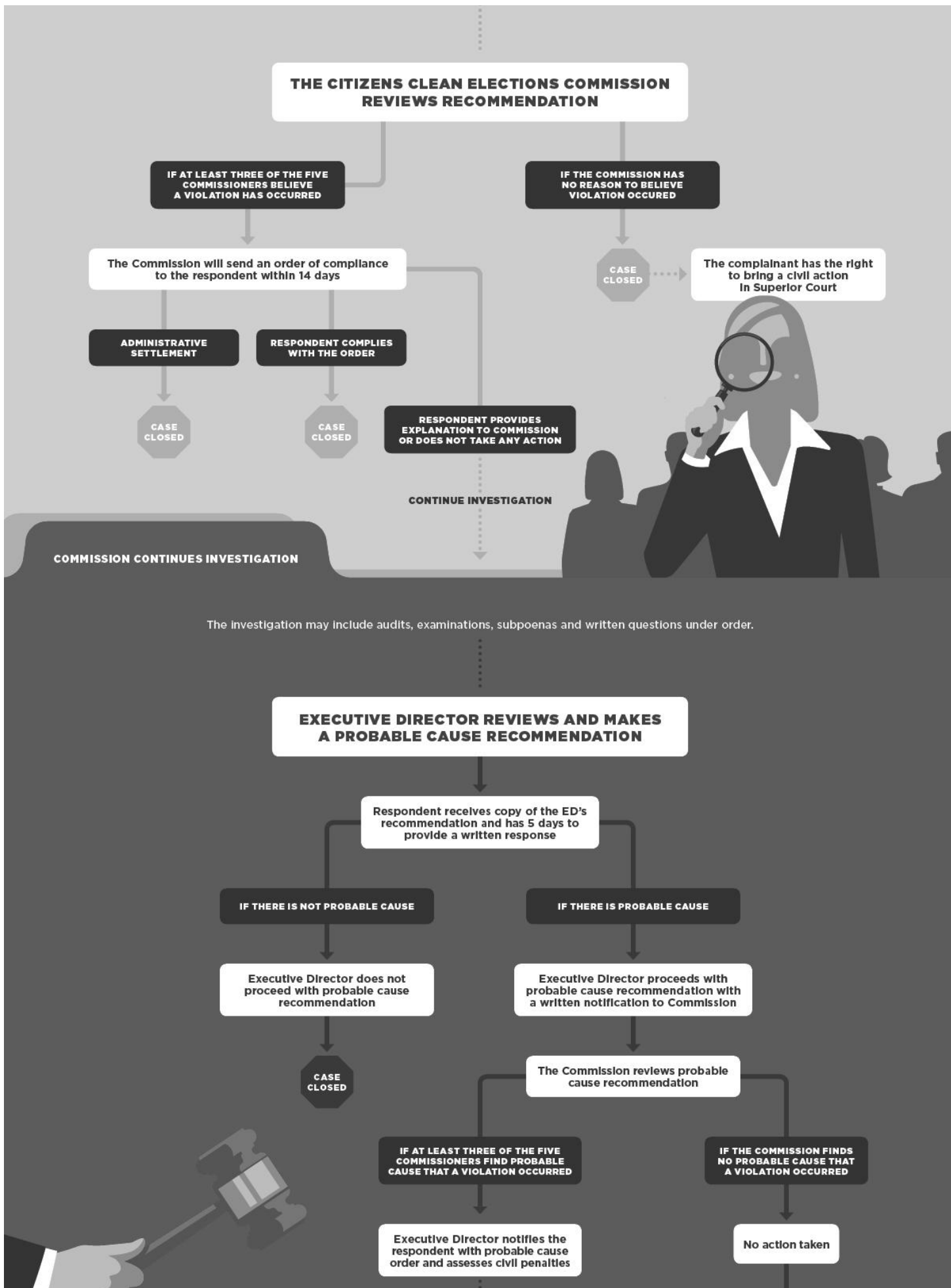


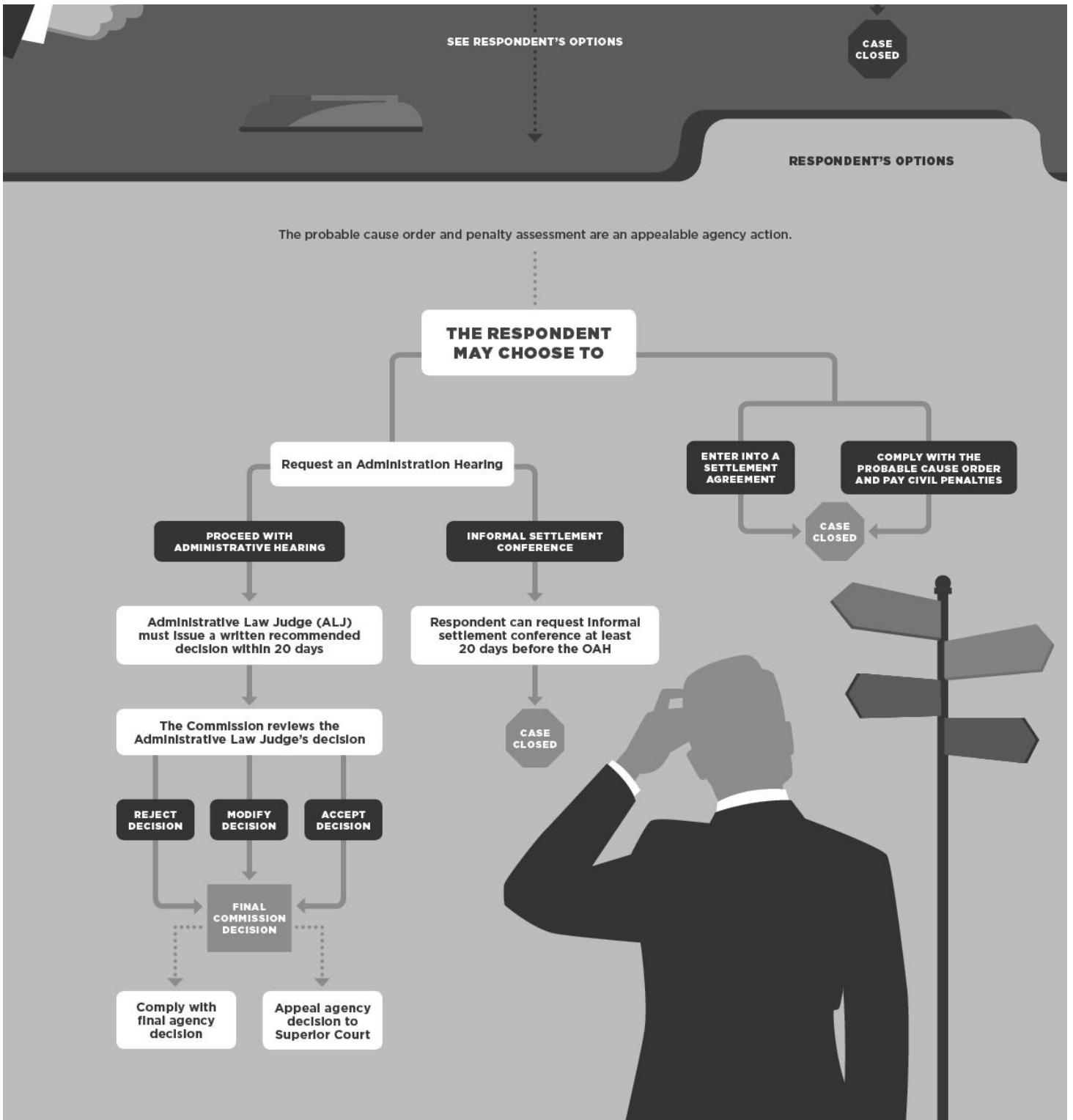
WHAT HAPPENS WHEN A COMPLAINT IS FILED?

COMPLAINT IS FILED AND PROCESSED

Complaints must contain the full name and address of the complainant, as well as a clear and concise recitation of the facts that describe a violation of statute or rule over which the Commission has jurisdiction. The complaint must be written, sworn to, signed in presence of a notary public and notarized.
