Attorney Chad Willis appeared on behalf of the City. Chairman Baca reviewed the PPC aloud and states

Complaint is timely filed. Attorney Willis stated the City does not agree the PPC is facially valid. The predetermination hearing notice was provided 120 days after the investigation ends. In his review of the CBA, he reads is that the Notice needs to be issued within 40 days after the 120 day investigation window but the notice can schedule the hearing outside of the 40 days period. The Complaint does not include when predetermination hearing was held, therefore, cannot determine whether or not the discipline was timely. No person appeared on behalf of APOA. Chairman Baca asked is the hearing needed to be held before March 12th, which is when the notice of discipline was issued.? Mr. Willis, stated, Yes.

Member Montoya moved to find facially valid. Chairman Baca seconded. Voted and passed 2-1, with Member Perlman voting No.
