On July 20, 2022, the Albuquerque Police Officers' Association, filed a Petition with the City of Albuquerque Labor-Management Relations Board seeking to be recognized as the exclusive bargaining representative of the employees in the unit described herein:

Civilian Investigators working in the City's Police Department's Internal Affairs Force Division (IAFD) excluding probationary, confidential, supervisory and management employees. (See Labor-Management Relations Ordinance, §§ 3-2-3, -7, and -9; and NMSA 1978 §§ 10-7E-4(Q), -4(G), -4(T), and -4(N)).

This request is based on the claim that a majority of the employees in the petitioned-for bargaining unit want to be represented by the above named employee organization.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION DESIRING TO REPRESENT ANY OF THE EMPLOYEES IN THE UNIT DESCRIBED IN THIS REQUEST FOR RECOGNITION HAS THE RIGHT, WITHIN TEN (10) WORKDAYS (LMRB Rule 2.15(A)) FOLLOWING THE DATE OF POSTING OF THIS NOTICE, TO FILE WITH THE BOARD AN INTERVENTION SUPPORTED BY AT LEAST A 30% SHOWING OF INTEREST (LMRB Rule 2.15(B)) OF THE EMPLOYEES IN THE UNIT REQUESTED OR OF THE EMPLOYEES IN A UNIT CLAIMED TO BE APPROPRIATE.
