On October 15, 2024, the Communications Workers of America filed a Petition for Representation with the City of Albuquerque Labor-Management Relations Board (Board) seeking certification of the Communications Workers of America (CWA) as the exclusive bargaining agent for all Triage Specialists in the City of Albuquerque's (City) Community Safety Department and inclusion of them in the existing bargaining unit covered by the CWA at the Community Safety Department.

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE ORGANIZATION DESIRING TO REPRESENT ANY OF THE EMPLOYEES IN THE UNIT DESCRIBED IN THIS REQUEST FOR CERTIFICATION HAS THE RIGHT, WITHIN TEN (10) DAYS (LMRB Rule 2.15(A)) FOLLOWING THE DATE OF POSTING OF THIS NOTICE, TO FILE WITH THE BOARD AN INTERVENTION SUPPORTED BY AT LEAST A 30% SHOWING OF INTEREST (LMRB Rule 2.15(B)) OF THE EMPLOYEES IN THE UNIT REQUESTED OR OF THE EMPLOYEES IN A UNIT CLAIMED TO BE APPROPRIATE.**

THIS NOTICE SHALL BE POSTED IN PLACES WHERE NOTICES TO EMPLOYEES ARE NORMALLY POSTED AND IN PLACE(S) CONSPICUOUS TO THE CITY EMPLOYEES IN THE BARGAINING UNIT. THIS NOTICE MUST REMAIN POSTED FOR AT LEAST FIVE (5) CONSECUTIVE WORKDAYS OR AT LEAST UNTIL: November 26, 2024 (LMRB Rule 2.14).
