• COUNTING AND TALLYING OF ELECTRONIC ELECTION VOTES FOR LB 22-36, COMMUNICATIONS WORKERS OF AMERICA'S PETITION FOR CERTIFICATION AND REPRESENTATION FOR BEHAVIORAL HEALTH RESPONDERS, COMMUNITY RESPONDERS, MOBILE CRISIS TEAM CLINICIAN ANS STREET OUTREACH RESOURCE COORDINATORS IN THE CITY OF ALBUQURQUE COMMUNITY SAFETY DEPARTMENT, AND OTHER ELECTION MATERS.

Member Montoya made a motion to consider the challenged votes, either way the CWA would certify as an exclusive representative. Board counsel Leigh Brunner pointed out that the City

must allow for a 5 day objection period after the tally of votes. Counsel for the City Victoria Gammill stated that eh Board could certify the election now subject to the 5-day objection period. After further discussion, Chairman Baca suggested a motion to accept the tally. Member Montoya motioned to accept the tally, 18 votes for CWA, and certify CWA as a collective bargaining agent, pending the 5-day wait for objections. Chairman Baca seconded the motion.
