NOTICE AND DIRECTION OF REPRESENTATION ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Albuquerque Labor Management Relations Board (“Board”) will conduct a representation election on Monday, November 28, 2022. Section 3-2-7(D)(2) of the City of Albuquerque’s Labor Management Relations Ordinance provides in relevant part that if eligible employees demonstrate sufficient interest, the Board shall call and hold a representation election to determine whether an employee organization shall be the exclusive representative of a bargaining unit. The bargaining unit whose members are eligible to vote in the election is the Behavioral Health Responders, Community Responders, and Street Outreach Resource Coordinators in the City of Albuquerque’s Community Safety Department, excluding probationary, confidential, supervisory and management employees. Each City Department with employees eligible to vote shall post copies of this notice at least 10 days before the election and take reasonable measures to assure that they are not removed, covered, altered or defaced. A copy of this notice shall also be posted on the Board's website at [Labor Management Relations Board — City of Albuquerque \(cabq.gov\)](#) .

The procedure for challenging ballots is as follows:

Challenge Instructions

1. Through its representative, any party to the election may challenge the eligibility to vote of any person who casts an electronic ballot.
2. Challenges will be sent by email to the City Clerk's office at cityclerk@cabq.gov with *Vote Challenge LB 22-36* in the subject line. The body of the email must state the name of the party making the challenge, the name and job classification of the challenged voter or voters, and the reason for the challenge for each voter.
3. Following the voting, the board shall attempt to resolve the eligibility of challenged voters by agreement of the parties. The ballots of challenged voters who are agreed eligible shall be processed electronically with the other ballots.
4. If the number of unresolved, challenged ballots could be determinative of the election, they will be investigated by the board as soon as possible to determine voter eligibility. If an investigation is conducted, the board shall declare the tally inconclusive, and will issue a report on the determination of voter eligibility or a notice of hearing within 15 days of the election. Any party may request board review of the board's report, following the procedures set forth in Section 2.20 of the board's rules.
