Notice of Rule and Regulation-Making Hearing

On June 25, 2009, at 3:00 PM, at the Los Altos Golf Course Banquet Room, the City of Albuquerque Parks & Recreation Department will hold a public hearing conducted by a city hearing officer regarding adopting rules and regulations for the Golf Division. The City's Golf Advisory Board will participate in the hearing and provide comment.

Among the proposed rules and regulations to be considered is the proposal of the Parks & Recreation Department to increase the green fees at the City of Albuquerque Municipal Golf Courses (\$.50) for each play for 18-hole and a 9-hole play for youth, senior, and regular players.
