OI SPONSORED BY: Renée Grout, Nichole Rogers 1 ORDINANCE 2 AMENDING THE INTEGRATED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE REGARDING 3 APPEAL COSTS. 4 WHEREAS, Policy 4.1.4 states that "Neighborhoods: Enhance, protect and 5 preserve neighborhoods and traditional communities as key to our long-term 6 health and vitality." BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 7 8 ALBUQUERQUE: 9 SECTION 1. The IDO Section 6-4(U)(5) Appeal Costs is amended as follows: 10 6-4(U)(5) Appeal Costs: Deletion 11 (a) For an appeal to the LUHO related to an application that was 12 denied, all parties shall be responsible for their own costs. (b) For an appeal to the LUHO related to an application that was 13 **Bracketed/Strikethrough Material** 14 approved, if the appellant loses their appeal, they shall be responsible for 15 paying a total of \$1,000 for the costs and fees of the appellee. A finding on 16 costs and fees shall be made by the LUHO. The \$1,000 amount shall not apply 17 to any individual appellant that demonstrates hardship, low income or indigent status, or entity appellant that has a majority of its area within an area that has 18 19 an overall score of 50 or greater on the City of Albuquerque's Social Vulnerability Index, as determined by the LUHO's discretion. 20 21 SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, 22 word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or 23 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council 24
