



1 parking permit area will become effective only upon the City Council's  
2 approval of the respective executive communication.

3 (4) The residents or the entity or event which causes the need for  
4 such on street parking, or the permitted residents may be required to pay for  
5 all direct and indirect costs caused by, or associated with, permit parking.

6 (C) Permit parking may be created on a pilot basis or by the Department  
7 of Municipal Development if permit parking may resolve special  
8 circumstances affecting an area."

9 SECTION 2. Enactment of this Ordinance constitutes the amendments  
10 contemplated by 'Section 1' and 'Section 2' of R-21-144 (Enactment R-2021-  
11 018). However, the City shall evaluate the residential parking permit area  
12 restrictions on Trellis Drive and Decker Road between Campbell Road and  
13 Candelaria Road pursuant to the changes enacted herein, and re-initiate  
14 enforcement or otherwise rescind, fully or partially, the restrictions on those  
15 streets only as deemed appropriate based on its evaluation.


16 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence,  
17 clause, word or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or  
18 unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not  
19 affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The Council  
20 hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,  
21 paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any  
22 provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.

23 SECTION 4. COMPILATION. Section 1 of this ordinance shall amend, be  
24 incorporated in and compiled as part of the Revised Ordinances of  
25 Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.

26 SECTION 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days  
27 after publication by title and general summary.
