Section 2-12-1 of the Capital Improvements Program Ordinance 8 is amended as follows: 9 "§ 2-12-1 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM INTENT; SCOPE. 10 (Q) 1. \$13.5 million of the 2025 General Obligation Bond Program is Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion 11 reserved for a Council district set-aside to be divided equally amongst [Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 the nine City Councilors; 13 2. \$15.75 million of the 2027 General Obligation Bond Program is 14 reserved for a Council district set-aside to be divided equally amongst 15 the nine City Councilors; and 16 3. \$18 million of the 2029 General Obligation Bond Program, and 17 all subsequent programs, is reserved for a Council district set-aside to 18 be divided equally amongst the nine City Councilors." SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, paragraph, sentence, 19 20 clause, word, or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid 21 or unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall 22 not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance. The 23 Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each 24 section, paragraph, sentence, clause, word, or phrase thereof irrespective of 25 any provisions being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
