COUNCIL BILL NO. 0-25-92 SPONSORED BY: Tammy Fiebelkorn 1 ORDINANCE 2 AMENDING § 5-8-6 "PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES" OF THE ALBUQUERQUE OPEN 3 SPACE MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE TO INCLUDE OVERLOOKED ANIMALS. 4 WHEREAS, all wildlife within Albuquerque's Open Space Lands and 5 Regional Preserves should be protected to preserve the ecological integrity 6 and natural balance of these environments; and 7 WHEREAS, the current Albuquerque Open Space Management Ordinance 8 does not explicitly list fish as protected wildlife, creating ambiguity in 9 enforcement and interpretation; and 10 WHEREAS, several ponds and aquatic habitats exist within Open Space Bracketed/Strikethrough Material] - Deletion 11 Lands, and the City Council has received reports of prohibited activities such Bracketed/Underscored Material] - New 12 as fishing, indicating a need to clarify the ordinance to ensure consistent 13 protection of all wildlife species. 14 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL, THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF 15 **ALBUQUERQUE:** 16 SECTION 1. § 5-8-6 PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES of the Albuquerque Open 17 **Space Management Ordinance is amended as follows:** 18 (F) Wildlife. No person shall intentionally feed, harm, hunt, pursue, molest, 19 harass, trap, collect, or remove any mammal, bird, reptile, fish, invertebrate, or 20 amphibian animals or eggs or young of said animals on/from Open Space 21 Lands or Regional Preserves where prohibited without an authorized scientific 22 research permit from the Open Space Division, with the exception of activities 23 conducted by approved government entities. Species that are deemed a public 24 health concern are exempted from the protections of this prohibition. 25 SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, 26 word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or

	1	unenforceable by any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not
	2	affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance. The Council
	3	hereby declares that it would have passed this Ordinance and each section,
	4	paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof irrespective of any
	5	provision being declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid.
	6	SECTION 3. COMPILATION. SECTION 1 of this Ordinance amends, is
	7	incorporated in, and is to be compiled as part of the Revised Ordinances of
	8	Albuquerque, New Mexico, 1994.
	9	SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance takes effect five days after
	10	publication by title and general summary.
