ORDER REGARDING CONDUCT OF EVIDENTIARY HEARING

The briefs shall limited to no more than 7 double spaced pages. No response briefs by either party are permitted. Briefs must be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk via email addressed to <u>mdiemer@cabq.gov</u>.
