ORDER REGARDING APPEAL

With regard to that appeal, the Board orders as follows:

- 1. No later than 5:00 PM on Monday, October 25, 2021, Complainant may submit a brief containing legal authorities related to the legal issues to be considered by the Board in the context of this appeal.
- 2. No later than 5:00 PM on Friday, November 5, 2021, Respondent and/or the City Clerk each may submit a brief containing legal authorities related to the legal issues to be considered by the Board in the context of this appeal.

3. All briefs shall be limited in scope to the issues related to the appeal of the City Clerk's rejection of the complaint. All briefs shall limited to no more than 7 double spaced pages. No additional briefing will be permitted. Briefs must be submitted to the Office of the City Clerk via email addressed to mdiemer@cabq.gov.

4. The City Clerk shall schedule a hearing on the appeal in a timely manner
