**PETITION FOR CERTIFICATION

REPRESENTATION
JANUARY 27, 2023**

The undersigned Albuquerque Investigators Association (AIA) representative is hereby submitting AIA membership cards pursuant to Sections 3-2-7 (A) and 3-2-7 (C) of the City of Albuquerque's (City) Labor Management Relations Ordinance (LMRO) and Rules 2.7, 2.8, 2.10 and 2.31 of the City's Labor Management Relations Board (Board). The AIA requests the Board certify the AIA as the exclusive bargaining agent for all City Internal Affairs Force Division Civilian Investigators employed with the City's Police Department.


Since this petition includes AIA membership cards authorizing and designating the AIA as the exclusive bargaining agent from a majority of the eligible civilian investigators, the AIA requests immediate certification of the AIA as the employees' exclusive bargaining agent (3-2-7 LMRO). The AIA believes all eligible employees have signed cards.

The AIA is located at 12124 Calle Zagal N.E, Albuquerque, NM 87111. The City's Police Department is headquartered at 400 Roma NW, Albuquerque, NM 87102, and their phone number is 505-768-2200.

The investigators are currently unrepresented by a bargaining agent. The investigators work at the Police Headquarters building.

Since the employee showing of interest exceeds the "50% plus one" requirement for certification without an election, the AIA respectfully requests the Board certify the AIA as the investigators' exclusive bargaining representative as quickly as possible.
