

Introduction

Whereas, the general assembly finds that the cost of running for statewide office has risen over the last decade at a rate far in excess of the increase in the cost of living; and

Whereas, the general assembly finds that the need to raise ever larger sums of money to effectively compete for general office threatens the essence of our democratic system by excluding many well qualified candidates; and

Whereas, the general assembly finds that the candidate's need to raise large sums of money can result in disproportionate and inappropriate influence being obtained by those who possess the financial ability to make large contributions to campaigns; and

Whereas, the general assembly finds that the state cannot impose limitations on the amount of private funds raised and expended for election purposes by a candidate unless it provides for at least partial public financing of campaigns;

Therefore, the general assembly determines that it is in the best interest of the citizens of the state to provide public financing to qualified candidates for general office. [RIGL 17-25-18]

The Board of Elections publishes this report of candidates for general office pursuant to the public financing provisions of Chapter 25 of Title 17.

Matching Public Funds Calculations

17-25-20(2)(ii): Eligibility criteria for matching public funds

The limitations on contributions received from private sources, matching funds available from the state, and total permitted expenditures shall apply in the 1994 general election and shall, subject to appropriations by the general assembly, increase by a percentage to be determined by the board of elections in January of each year in which a general election involving general officers is held, beginning in 1998. In no case shall the increase exceed the total increase in the consumer price index since the month in which the previous general election involving general was held.

Calculating the percentage change in CPI from November 2014 to November 2017: [CPI November 2017 (246.669) / CPI November 2014 (236.151)] $-1 \times 100\% = 4.45\%$

Dear Mayor Allan W. Fung:

In accordance with section 17-25-25 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, any candidate receiving public funds is required to transfer to the General Treasurer 50% of any unexpended funds for deposit into the State's General Fund.

Based upon the reports submitted to the Board of Elections ("Board") for the 2018 election cycle, and recognizing adjustments occurring in Q1 2019 for returning overcontributions (\$606.00) and receiving refunds from advertising (\$15,858.00), the Board determined that your campaign had adjusted unexpended campaign funds of \$17,322.76. Thus, 50% of that amount, or \$8,661.38, is due and payable to the General Treasurer of the State of Rhode Island.
