**13. Pastor Repp; What is Sex Trafficking?**

- Criminal act defined as “Recruitment harboring and transportation, provision, patronizing, or solicitation of a person. For commercial gain or anything of value, through force, fraud or coercion.
- Under the age of 18, the person is considered a victim, not a criminal
- Worldwide H.T brings in 150 billion dollars yearly.
- Three major types;
  1. Loverboy Trafficking
  2. Familial Sex Trafficking
  3. Gang Controlled Trafficking
- Where Traffickers recruit
- Why don't the trafficked just leave?
- What do you do if you suspect Human Trafficking?

- Much higher rates since Covid lockdown
- Our biggest problem is that we have nowhere to send the girls.
- Spoke about working with federal agencies
- APD Doesn't track numbers on immigrants, but Sex Trafficking of immigrants happens often.
