 - How to advocate for members of the legislature and keep within the timeline.
 - If you don't know your state legislator or senator/representative, go to the secretary of state website.
 - Any citizen in NM can request legislation to get drafted.
 - Citizen legislature – They meet thirty or sixty days every other year. This year they met for a thirty-day session.
 - They have interim committees

- In the state house some representatives or districts are working closely with the Albuquerque Community Policing Council.
- Bills can be introduced by the governor or member of the legislature before the session starts. Primarily two weeks before, on opening day, or halfway through the session.
- When the bill starts in the House, it gets assigned to two committees. It goes to a policy committee and a substantive committee.
- The policy committee consists of:
 - Consumer public affairs
 - Health committee
 - Energy
 - Economic Develop
- The substantive committee
 - Judiciary
 - Appropriations or tax and revenue
- If the bill gets passed by both committees it gets voted on the House floor or senate
- The first step in the legislature draft
 - You would need to get ahold of city counselors
 - Ask a legislature to draft it
 - Start talking to others about the legislation to get votes on it.
- This year the session was for thirty days
