5. Warden Kai Smith, Metro Detention Center

- The count for the detention center is 1854, and according to the McClendon Settlement, the maximum number of people is 1950. If they are at that number or near that amount, the detention center has twenty days to release people.
- There are 287 staff members
 - o Dayshift 149 officers (52%)
 - o Courts and transfers 42 officers (28%)
 - o Swing shift 82 officers (29%)
 - o The officers have an eight-hour shift.
- There are currently twenty-five cadets in the academy.
- The philosophy he goes by is security and support.
 - o Consistency and accountability.

- They help with job training, getting those individuals back on their own, and offer assistance.
- There is an online dashboard showing who has been in MDC in the last thirty days.
 - o On the website, there are stats on how many individuals were brought in from the different law enforcement agencies.
