- 4. FH Area Commander Aaron Jones' crime update**
 - He started at the FH Area Command last year in September
 - CAD numbers from last month (May)
 - Auto theft – 64
 - Auto burglary – 39
 - Residential burglary – 16
 - Commercial burglary – 7
 - Robberies armed/carjacking/individual/Residential/Commercial – 11
 - Auto thefts warm up – 2
 - The Touch a Truck event was successful, and there were about 5,000 to 7,000 people who attended.
 - They are staying level with the bid from February
 - The officers completed their on-the-job training (OJT) and served as new officers.
 - National Night Out
 - National Guard
 - Earlier this year, a conversation was held to discuss support services, and it was suggested to request assistance from the National Guard.
 - There are sixty National Guard personnel coming and serving in multiple functions.
 - There are four things they are working on: uniform personnel in different area commands. These areas are in the east central, university, SE, and FH.
 - There will be two soldiers per shift

- They are doing scene security. They will not be armed and will be driving government vehicles equipped with emergency equipment. The vehicles will not have lights like a police car, but yellow lights.
 - Assisting in the real-time crime center
 - Providing real-time information to officers as they're responding to your call.
 - Drone program- some national guardsmen will have that background, whether they are trained to assist in facilitating drone programs for the city.
 - Assisting at the prisoner transport center with administrative functions.
 - Assisting in the shield unit with administrative functions
