

## Foothills Community Policing Council March 11, 2024

- 4. DA Sam Bregman
  - He's been in office for over a year. There were less than 80% of prosecutors, in
    his first fourteen months his office hired about 50 lawyers. This included fiftynine support staff with a total of hundred and nine staff added since he got into
    office.
  - There are about 14,000 open cases from last year.
    - o 2023 there were 7904 cases, that's an increase from 2020 of 6000 cases
  - Data and stats
    - o 2022 58% in felony conviction rate
    - o 68.5% conviction rate
    - o Misdemeanor conviction rate a rough estimate of 81%
  - Felony trials
    - o In 2022 they had 22
    - o In 2023 they had 111
    - o In 2024 YTD they had 26
  - Backlog of Sexual Assault kits
    - o In 2023 they indicted sixteen different sexual assault cases.
  - There are twelve sworn officers known as special agents in the DA's office.
    - o In 2023 between three agencies they cleared 727 warrants and 21 of those warrants were charged with murder.
  - File pretrial detention motion for those who are a danger to the community
    - o In 2022 there were 1053 58% granted
    - o In 2023 there were 1088 33% granted
    - o In 2024 there were averaging about the same 68% granted
  - More resources for specialty courts

- o There is one full-time prosecutor handling drug charges. In 2023 they had 348 cases.
- o Drug court, juvenile court, and adult court
- In 2023 twenty-one juveniles were charged with murder, and sixteen of them were charged with 1<sup>st</sup> degree murder. In most of these cases, a gun was involved.
- Shoplifting
  - Working with BCSO and APD
- They have a 0-tolerance policy for schools
  - o If anyone has a gun on campus there will be an arrest warrant and arrest the individual.

## 6. SWAT Lt. Josh Richards

- The year-to-date call for SWAT is 82, serving all agencies.
- The SWAT and K-9 staff there are twenty operators and four sergeants.
- The bomb squad has eight operators
- In 2024 they had roughly sixteen SWAT activation
- They are 24-7 on call.
- They post on social media when SWAT is in the area and areas to avoid.
