- 1. Call to order – 6:00 PM**
- 2. Approval of agenda – (November) Approved**
- 3. Approval of minutes – (October) Approve**
- 4. NE Area Commander Amy Sedler crime update**
 - With the government shutdown, they haven't seen a difference.
 - Top priorities – Fall operations
 - Positive relationships with business owners
 - Each officer must have three interactions with three different businesses, and the command staff will do the same. The commander and Lt. will handle business contacts.
 - Balloon fiesta – Lt. Pete Silva took the lead on a hotel/motel operation. The operation included 17 local hotels/motels in the NE area command. They focused on presence and periodic watches at locations, aiming to decrease crime and theft. More specifically, auto theft and auto burglary.
 - Gearing up for the holiday tactic plan, focusing on Uptown and Coronado Mall.
 - October Calls for service 8253
 - Traffic stops – 336
 - Calls for service related to domestic issues – 350
 - Aggravated battery and assaults – 118
 - Robberies – 20
 - Auto burglaries – 27
 - Residential burglaries – 27
 - Commercial burglaries – 40
 - Auto theft – 64
 - Disturbances – 746
 - They are working alongside Sandia Pueblo for the next couple of months on an operation specific to drag racing.
 - Consists of overtime officers, NE officers, the traffic unit, and air support.
 - Sgt. Orion Murphy NE PRT Team
 - Take care of businesses

- Address problems like homelessness in parks,
- They don't take calls for service unless pertaining to their mission
- Primarily focusing on retail. They also go and find encampments, cite people for doing drugs, and they go after stolen vehicles that are located in the NE are commanded
- There are six officers, one on military leave, so a total of five officers.
- The month of October, they executed and located 22 felony warrants
- 411 felony arrest
- Executed 21 misdemeanor warrants and 14 misdemeanor arrests.
- Between felony and misdemeanor arrests, 13 were related to shoplifting that tallied \$5,942, which was recovered and returned to the store.
- Located and apprehended people found in stolen cars; cleared eight of them.

5. New Member voted for the NE CPC

6. NE Crime Prevention Specialist

- City reinstated the window-grant program for businesses with vandalized windows.
- There are two requirements
 - Small business with fewer than 25 employees.
 - Require Crime Prevention Specialist to conduct SEPTED security survey.
 - Go online to the city website to apply
- People going out of town and traveling, make sure you're securing your homes. Let friends and neighbors know to keep an eye on your home.
 - You can call the substation to request a periodic watch.
