4. **APD Interim Chief of Police Cecily Barker**
 - 2025 started out in a good place and got out of the consent decree.
 - 2026 – stats and data look good
 - Concentrate on the perception of crime
 - Property crime down 23% year to date
 - Auto theft down 38% year to date
 - Shootings down 41% year to date
 - Year to date – 2025, a high number of felony and misdemeanor arrests
 - 2026 -2025 up 31% felony arrest
 - 2026-2025 up 21% misdemeanor arrest
 - Respond proactively to calls for service from officers.
 - Homicides were 5, down from 6 last year. The clearance rate is above 90%
 - Recruiting – there were 99 officers who joined APD last year.
 - The Bid will start in April, and there will be 43 more officers working in the field.
 - Transit 17 – they focus on the buses and the central corridor.
