8. Internal Affairs Force Division Deputy Commander Adam Anaya

- APD is one of the few Departments in America with an Internal Affairs Force Division, which is now being duplicated in other cities.
- They had a back log of 600 plus cases.
- There are zero cases in back log within the last two years
- Cases are staying within there timeline.
- The team is mix with civilian and sworn employees. There are twenty-one investigators with a couple in training. The team is fully staffed.
- EFIT came in with individuals who have law significant enforcement experience
- On average each investigator has two to three cases, concurrently
- He compiled a *how-to when an incident happens* manual for future investigators.
