 - Bought more cameras
 - San Pedro revitalization project – construction is hopefully starting this year, with landscaping, ADA-accessible sidewalks, and protected bike lanes.
 - Adding two speed trailers.
 - District 7 – road diet on Lomas restriping,
 - physical changes to Manual.

 - Adopt a business initiative in April 2026. Originally started in 2025 and received good feedback. There are 60 officers assigned to local businesses. Meeting the goal of law enforcement and business awareness.
 - The three directed activities focus on traffic enforcement in Montgomery and are scheduled to start on the 15th.

7. AFR Lt. Gary Davis

- Question: How to ban fireworks?
 - Reach out to their state legislature to do a statewide ban.
- Constitutes the legal – more than 6 ft in the air is illegal, and makes a loud noise.
- The main thing has to be witnessed by a fire marshal or by an officer.
- They are patrolling on the 4th of July and the day before the 4th of July; if witnesses are found, they will issue citations.
- Bill passed out of the committee last night. She's sponsoring the work on copper theft. Require certain record-keeping from recyclers and pawn shops. The bill will be heard after the summer break.
- On July 27th and July 28th, we will host a de-escalation specifically for businesses at the SE substation. They are going to have their crisis intervention team come out and teach business owners de-escalation techniques. The first day is 9 AM – 11 AM, and 2nd day is 11 AM to 1 PM
- National Night Out on August 4, 2026. First Tuesday in August: registration opens, and it will close on July 30th or 31st.
