 - Challenges
 - Their staffing is at 74% (that's an increase since he's been there)
 - There are 411 positions filled for officer levels, meaning boots on the ground, that's the minimum staffing guide.
 - There is technology that makes the job easier; however, it's a lot of responsibility because someone needs to monitor the system.
 - Currently, the MDC is sitting at 1818 people as of noon today (7/8/2025). The capacity is 1,950, which is court ordered, and the building is being built for 2,000. According to the McLendon court order, it states they can't go over 1950 without exercising some options. Some forced option about community release.
 - Housing MDC Deputy Warden McCain
 - Receive discharge and transfer area is known as the intake area. When individuals are booked into custody, they go there.
 - After they get taken to the intake housing units,
 - Four of those are currently located in what they call a room unit. This area is restricted housing. In these units, they have individuals dealing with substance abuse and going through detox. These individuals are being monitored.
 - The other restricted housing unit houses individuals who are at a higher risk or have disciplinary issues within the facility, and are pending process.
 - Psychological service unit – individuals with mental health illnesses
 - Shelter housing unit – Individuals with more chronic medical situations and A&V are monitored by medical care.

- There are three general population units. Two are all units, and the other is a dormitory unit.
 - Dormitory – individuals who are sentenced, and they work around the facility.
- Programming – deals mostly with life skills for individuals, both male and female.
- ATP Program – Those who are court-ordered and must participate in a 28-day substance abuse program. Which is held at the dormitory unit, which is the DEA.
- Budget- Highest budget in the county. They have over \$100 million, of which a significant portion goes outside of payroll, and medical contracts with UNM-H

5. NE Crime Prevention Specialist

- Auto theft prevention – if parked on a driveway or street, remember to lock your doors, and don't leave anything of value in your car.
- There is new technology where the key fobs can be duplicated. The signal that is sent out, people can get the signal and create new key fobs and break into the cars.
- When doing welfare checks, call 242-cops or 911. The 311 system has a delay.
- To get a hold of ACS, call 242-cops, and with encampments, if they can wait a couple of days, call 311.

 - Nordstrom Rack in Winrock, July 19, 2025, from 10 am -12 pm. The OCU detectives will be there talking about retail theft and other issues. The NE Crime Prevention Specialist will be there handing out flyers and tabling stuff.
