5. NW Area Commander update Chris Patterson

- Come aboard to the NW area command two months ago.
- The commander provided 2023 stats and reported that there was a reduction in all crimes.
 - o Aggravated assaults were down 12%
 - o Robberies were down 48%
 - o Sex crimes were down 8%
 - Auto burglaries were down 5%
 - o Regular burglaries were down 12%
 - o Auto theft was down 13%

- He is working with city councilor Dan Lewis to obtain automatic license plate readers.
- Proactive teams consist of two officers and a sergeant. The PRT recovered over \$10,000 worth of merchandise from shoplifting.
- Calls for service in the last thirty days 2405
- Proactive calls in three areas include traffic stops, business checks, welfare checks, and tactical operations.
