4. **NW PRT Team**
 - Tact plan 3rd year in NW, covering West Bluff, Riverside, and Cottonwood District.
 - Mobile substation in the Cottonwood Mall area, cameras in various businesses.
 - They will have overtime officers there working Tuesday – Thursday, with the possibility of Mondays if they sign up for overtime. Starting 11/28 to ½
 - Auto theft
 - Horse mounting
 - Organized crime unit
 - Traffic support, hopefully 2x a week
 - There will be 12 PSA's
 - Including 4 officers and two overtime officers each day.
 - Aggravated assaults down 14.7%
 - Robberies down 26.7%
 - Sex crimes up 10.4% five incidents more than 2024, due to delayed reporting and single instances.
 - Auto burglary down 24%
 - Commercial/Residential burglary down 5.4%
 - Shoplifting down 10.6% YTD 7-day compared to 2024 and 2025, down by 40.9%
 - Auto theft down 41.6
 - Crime trends are down.
 - Traffic Tact plan
 - 2024 – 6335 citations

- Coors – 924 citations 271 traffic stops
- Unser – 674 citations 173 traffic stops
- Ladera – 1043 citations 281 traffic stops
- Fall operation completed 4 weeks ago, 5,000 community contacts
