- 6. SW Area Commander Chris Patterson Crime update**
 - Staffing – The NW is down one officer, that officer applied for the DWI and got accepted. There are twelve officers in their last month of OJT.
 - The academy class will be graduating twenty officers in three weeks. Then they go on OJT.
 - The commander stated that there is a good improvement in crime trends.
 - Assault is down 13%
 - Robberies are down 57% a reduction from last year.
 - Sex crime is down 27%
 - Auto burglary is down 5%

- Burglary is down 38%
- Shoplifting is down 28%
- Auto theft – down 40%
- The city shut down the motel six on Coors
- ShotSpotter increased in the area. They added the Cottonwood Mall area a couple of months back and they are seeing a low number of ShotSpotter activation.
- Graveyard doing an attack plan. They call it a race track. They are driving around in a set area during those high peak times when ShotSpotter activates. Those activated times are around 2 am. They did notice then after a shift in time to 7 pm, so they are sending resources to those spots.
- Speed cameras in the city will be extended, so there will be more cameras in the city.
