4. NW Area Commander Chris Patterson's crime update

- Recommendation of stats reported to the CPC is still being worked on.
- Crime is looking good, and some crime increased by double digits.
- Aggravated assaults increased by 15%
- Auto burglary, Residential & Commercial robbery/burglary down 3%
- Shoplifting up 70%
- In the last two weeks they had five calls for service for shoplifting in progress. There were six arrests made within those five calls.
- Traffic tactic plan that the commander started when he came to the Northwest.
 - \circ The traffic unit wrote 517 citations within those citations there were 120 traffic stops.
- The motor vehicles were on Coors today.
- The motor unit shut down a street racing event on Double Eagle. They issued twenty-five citations for racers and spectators.

- The commercial and auto burglary/robbery are happening due to open garages. Do not leave garage doors open.
- ATVs are illegal on the roads, and there is a city ordinance.
