- 4. Xochitl Campos-Biggs Chief Policy Advisor for APD**
 - Work with legislators to understand their priorities.
 - To ensure their subject matter experts are ready to participate in conversations with legislators and to explain to the legislature why it is important.
 - She is working on the crime initiative document to reflect what they are currently seeing.
 - Update on MCI, due at some point
 - Work on a domestic violence package and update the number of outdated statutes.
 - Looking into a copper theft bill
 - Work on homicide by vehicle. The bill was worked on for years and didn't go anywhere during the 30-day legislation.
 - The interim starts tomorrow, and she'll be in Santa Fe discussing where the meeting will take place and topics they will be working on.
 - MCI (metro crime initiative) should be ready in the next couple of weeks, hopefully by the next meeting, and she can attend to go through it.

 - Chris Patterson is retiring from APD
 - The new NW Area Commander is Pete Silva
 - Review the efficacy of the gas cards?
 - This was a pilot project ending in July. Officers are still using the cards. Those cards are being turned off sometime in June. After the data has been collected and reviewed by the Deputy Chief.
