- 4. NW Area Commander Chris Patterson's crime update**
 - Personnel changes in the NW area command
 - Lt. Middleton retired as of July 12
 - Lt. Wes Ivy is on the grave graveyard shift
 - Lt. Cabarea is being deployed for a year, and another Lt. will be coming on permanently.
 - PRT team – Four officers are addressing the hot spots throughout the NW area.
 - They are working in the Westbluff and Cottonwood area with the shot's spotter.
 - Other areas of concentration are Sequoia and Coors where they are moving resources due to shots going off.
 - Aggravated assaults are down 90%
 - Auto burglary is down 28%
 - Burglary down 14%
 - Robbery down 40%

- Auto thefts down 1% that is three more cars stolen compared to last year. The commander is working to get bait cars in the area, and LPR (license plate readers) in the area command they currently have two.
- Traffic tact plan – Traffic enforcement writing citations
 - 2973 citations 1 arrest 782 traffic stops avg. 3.8 citations per stop. The majority of these were on Coors Blvd
 - 1124 citations 214 warrants on unser and golf course
 - 846 citations 1 arrest on the west side. There was an individual who was going 90 MPH on a 35 MPH road.
 - 563 citations 144 stops on Ladera blvd.
 - 301 citations 77 traffic stops on Rainbow Street
