  - Aggravated Assaults; down for the month and year. The hotspots are West Bluff and, Unser-Ladera area.
  - Sex crimes four fewer incidents reported this month, and they were spread throughout the area command.
  - Robberies are up by three same as last year, and down 40% this year. The effected areas are businesses located near Alameda and Corrales, Coors, and Montano
  - Auto burglary down by 41% same as last year
  - Commercial and Residential burglaries are down 29% for the month and up 14% for the year.
  - Shoplifting incidents down 22% this year.

- Auto theft is down 14% year to date city-wide, 17% up in the 28 days from August 17-September 13
- NW down 20% over all in the 28days down 18%, mostly around apartment complexes
