• The VIP is under the Albuquerque Community Safety Department.

- Every Tuesday and Thursday they go out with the Deputy Commander Jason Janopoulos and go after the shooting reviews and look at the people who would retaliate or likely reoffend.
- They go out and talk to the victim and their families who were victimized by gun violence.
- Social services come in to help with resources such as therapy for the family and victim. They help as much as possible to deter retaliation
- Hospital base VIP working with UNM-H. When an individual comes in with a gun shot, the someone from VIP program will visit them bedside to help them and offer resources.
- They discovered that a lot of aggravated assaults and domestic violence tend to lead to gun violence.
- They go to the jails to deliver messages to those who been recently arrested, and work on pre-entry with then and when they get released they are not returning to the streets and repeating what they did.

8. Recommendation:

• Amnesty day for low level warrants, so that people can show up to court to clear past misdemeanor warrants
