- **4. Approval of Minutes** June and July approved
- 5. Erika Wilson, Manager of the Emergency Communications Center
 - Center handles inbound 911 calls and 242-cops
 - The call priority answers 911 calls over 242-cops
 - Budgeted for 163 operators, not fully staffed.
 - Oversees the 911 operators and, dispatchers, and supervisors. The staff provides information for courts.
 - Challenges in employment, they pull applications every two weeks.
 - Paid training and pre-hire plan academy.
 - The 911 operator starting pay \$23 an hour
 - o Dispatch \$24 an hour to complete a three-week
 - There is a \$2 raise after probation
 - o 911 operator \$28 plus other incentives
 - Positions are union

- Shift supervisors
- o Three administrative assistants provide data.
- o Lowered marijuana use requirements, but it is still a challenge.
- Training for six months and an additional six months training for dispatch position
- o Center handles 1.1 million phone calls yearly.
- o Operators receive 20 hours of mental health training.
- o Questions and discussions with community and CPC councilors

 - SE Area Command divided because area East of San Mateo is responsible for the majority of crime in the Command.
 - Pilot project created by the Mayor.
 - The new substation is located on 1009 Broadway SE
 - o Grand opening of the substation on August 25, 2023 at 11 AM
 - Crime report crime stat
 - o Aggravated assaults are high at 14%
 - o Sex crimes down 14%
 - o Robberies down 57%
 - o Auto burglaries down 18%

o Crime state 7 days		28 days	one year
o Auto burglary 83%		73%	18%
o Burglary	13%	36%	75%

- Shoplifting down 45%
- o Citations and arrest there were six shoplifters arrested
- o Chief wrote a letter to Walgreens.
