- Violent crime and Property crime
- Aggravated assaults up 20% compared from this year to last year. This year there
 were 139 compared to last year of 116.
- Sex crimes down by 42%. This year there were 7 compared to last year of 12
- Robberies down 54%, with 21 robberies this month.

• Property Crime

- o Auto theft is down
- o Auto Burglary is down 42%. This year there were 54 compared to last year of 93.
- o Burglary down 23%. This year there were 22 compared to last year of 103.
- o Shoplifting up 142%. This year there were 29 compared to last year of 12.
- Misdemeanor crimes
 - Shooting with injury down 20%
 - o Up one homicide- 5 vs 4
- Warrant round up every week.
 - \circ SE clearing the most felony arrest and warrants.
