5. **Mayor's office, Yvett Tovar – Vacant buildings on central**
 - The city council passed an ordinance last January regarding vacant premises. Regarding locations, 1st to 8th street, North – Copper, and South – Gold are affected by 137 properties.
 - The ordinance went into effect on July 1, 2025. Of the 137 vacant properties, 20 had to register and pay a fee ranging from \$1,000 to \$5,000 a year, depending on the area's square footage. There are two exceptions: the area is for sale under contract to be sold or under construction. Ready to launch a new business.

6. SW Crime Prevention Specialist Ron Kemp

- March statistics
- Residential burglary – 3 / 3 related to DV
- Auto burglary – 22 / 2 involved unlocked vehicles, 5 involved firearms taken from vehicles, and 2 were from unlocked vehicles.
- Commercial burglary – 10
- Auto theft – 21 / 7 of the vehicles were recovered
- Commercial robbery – 2

7. SW Area Commander Renee Barraza

- PRT on Central from 98th to east of SW. This tactic plan ends in March.
- There were 56 felony arrests
 - 44 cleared warrants
 - 9 misdemeanor warrants
 - 44 misdemeanors, new charges
- Stolen vehicles – 2
 - One gun recovered
 - 105 reports
 - Onsite – 477 / suspicious cars, persons, and situations.
- Warrant backlog – those who didn't update their address when released.
- Drivers of crime – The information comes from investigative bureaus and contacts the PRT for these individuals known in the SW. These individuals are involved in auto theft, burglary, or organized crime.
