5. **Southwest Area Commander Renee Barraza**
 - Every week executive staff goes through crime stats
 - There are two main categories: Violent crimes and Property Crimes
 - Violent crimes: Aggravated assaults YTD up 3%
 - Domestic violence related – 30%
 - Non-domestic violence related – 70%
 1. Any deadly weapon to firearm being used.
 - Sex crimes – YTD -33% in the twenty eight days no sex crimes in 2022
 - Robberies – TYD trending down in double digits. In 2023 there were six incidents and in 2022 they were -45%
 - Big events- State fair and balloon fiesta, increase patrol in the SW area command near the hotels and motels.
 - Staffing in the SW area – there are forty-five officers, ten Sgt's, and three watch commanders overseeing the graveyard/Day/Swing shift.
 - End of August a class graduating from on-the-job training and joining the forces.
 - There are thirty PSAs and on OJT (on-the-job training) for two months.

 - There are two teams
 - EFIT 1 – Investigate current cases
 - EFIT 2 – Investigate backlog cases
 - The transition is going well.
 - Drafting the eighth quarterly report
