- 4. Commander Jay Ratliff APD Crime Lab**
 - Scientific evidence division
 - Lab split into two sections
 - Criminalistics
 - Crime scene specialist
 - Various calls they collect/identify/ photograph
 - Major crime scene team – crime scenes and in-custody death
 - Forensics
 - There are three full-time units: DNA unit, Firearms & tool mark unit, chemistry unit, and leg & print unit.
 - Evidence division
 - All evidence is housed for APD and BCSO. They manage over 550,000 items in evidence as an active investigation.
 - Antivert – image and digital recovery, there are three employees
 - Identification unit – 24 hours a day, any person arrested within Bernalillo County gets a fingerprint to confirm identity and is entered into the APIS system, a federal database.
 - Assist in identifying through fingerprints through a live scan or fingerprint roll.
 - They employ 135 non-sworn employees, and the NCIST unit is sworn.

 - They are assisting in the Shield unit

- Prisoner transport unit
 - Scene security – take over for sworn officers' positions and hold perimeter.
