- 2. Approval of Agenda-** Approved
  - Chief H. Medina is not available; DC Cecily Barker, and DC JJ Griego will be in attendance
- 3. Approval of Minutes** – Approved (September)
- 4. Old/New Business** – Officer Involved shooting recommendation approved in September
- 5. VA citizens' comments** – the community constantly calls 311 and 242-cops regarding homeless encampments in their area. The question asked of the VA Area Commander is What else can be done about this issue?
- 6. APD DC Cecily Barker and DC JJ Griego**
  - There were over 15,000 to 20,000 people in the march. Fall operations will run throughout the next couple of months and focus on ensuring the community knows they are there. Not just issue citations or look for criminal activity, though that is a result of officers being out in the community, but also talk to businesses and understand the issues of concern. Also, follow up to see if the problems were addressed, and bring them back to the business owners.
  - Receiving complaints about the camera trailers about the use of narcotics in the area. Trying to address the issue by informing officers and undercover officers.
  - Violent crime lessens within the community, including property crime. Year to date, the city has 56 homicides, and last year they were at 84. Currently, the clearance rate is 95-100%.
  - Felony and misdemeanor arrests are up year-to-date compared to last year. There is a nearly 25% increase in felony arrests and a 17% increase in misdemeanor

arrests. Auto theft year-to-date is down 41% in the city. Auto burglaries and burglaries down 15-20%

- The recommendation was made in September. Administrative issues that have been resolved. The recommendation was sent to the wrong person, and it wasn't notified that it was sent to the wrong person, so no follow-up.
