  - Writing reports
  - EFIT – officer’s supervisor goes over the investigation with the officer and adds the investigation report to that officers file.
5. **Superintendent of Public Reform, Victor Valdez**
  - He began his duties in September 2022.
  - He started discussing the CASA, mention that APD should be around 90% in operations. He spoke of the City Council reorganization of the CPOA Board into an Advisory Committee with reduced authority. Currently, there is no executive director for the CPOA.
  - He provided his educational and professional background, and stated that he’s an independent contractor, and not a City of Albuquerque employee. He manages the office of superintendent and makes recommendations for change and reviews all disciplinary actions.
  - He reviews cases from the FRB (Force Review Board) for discrepancies.
  - One of other job functions is to be a public liaison for groups such as the CPC and Amici.
  - Became Superintendent out of concern for the City of Albuquerque.
  - Discussed civilian Internal Affairs investigators.
  - Other duties as assigned or requested by the mayor.
  - Participates in Community discussion about APD changes and policy.
  - Conducts monthly de-escalation officer of the month award.

6. Cmdr. Nick Wheeler spoke about APD mental health support and crisis intervention training.
