- 5. CPOA Executive Director Diane McDermott and CPOAB Aaron Calderon**
 - They discussed the functions of the CPOA and advisory board. She went over how the CPOA was created. The department is independent from the city, and APD. The CPOA receives complaints from citizens that get filed against an officer of the Albuquerque police department, including accommodations that get added to the officer's file. The CPOA investigators have 120 days to investigate the case and submit it to the lead investigator when completed.
 - The CPOAB has five members and began board meetings this year. The Board reviews the findings of the Executive Director for their information.

- 6. Valley Area Command Report Acting Commander Jose Sanchez**
 - The Monthly crime states on the website have not been updated since February
 - Auto theft – 178
 - Larceny – 368
 - Assaults – 346
 - In the last twenty-eight days they reallocated resources and saw a downward trend in assaults.
 - Auto burglary increased, including guns and firearms. Make sure your car door is locked.
 - The VA area command is working on a tact plan with the SW area command to deal with traffic and loud exhaust issues.
 - The downtown unit increased the swing shift by one officer.

- On June 21st the officers will be done with OJT and will be added to the swing shift.
- Teams overtime – businesses donate for officers working in the downtown area.
